3. The Manufacturer must perform a full First Article Inspection (FAI), or a partial FAI for the affected characteristics, when there is a lapse in production of two years for any item listed in the APMA Supplement.

4. Parts, appliances or services furnished by any suppliers located in a foreign country may not be used in the production of any APMA product unless:
- That part or service can and will be completely inspected for conformity at the authorised manufacturer's Australian facility; or
  - CASA has determined that the supplier's location places no undue burden upon CASA in administering the applicable airworthiness requirements; or
  - The parts/services furnished by the foreign supplier are produced under the provisions of an Australian Bilateral Airworthiness Agreement or Bilateral Aviation Safety Agreement and approved for import to Australia in accordance with regulation 21.502 of CASR.

The design data listed on the Supplement enclosed with this letter of approval is to be considered as approved data. This data is not to be altered by the Manufacturer unless permitted or approved by CASA.
